9. The authors undertake that their manuscript is not being evaluated for publication in any language in any other country.

### Guidelines for Authors

#### Purpose and editorial policy

The **Brazilian Journal of Agricultural Sciences** is published by the Federal Rural University of Pernambuco (UFRPE) to publish scientific and technical papers, for the advancement of Agricultural Science. The areas contemplated are: Agronomy, Agricultural Engineering, Animal, Fisheries and Forestry Sciences and Veterinary Medicine. The papers submitted should be original and unpublished, and their simultaneous submission to other periodicals is unacceptable. Reproduction of published articles is permitted, as long as the source is explicitly cited.

#### Format and preparation of manuscripts

The paper will be submitted to publication through the Journal portal (<http://www.agraria.pro.br/ojs-2.4.6>), by the corresponding author, which will be responsible for the article for the remaining authors.

Papers will only be accepted after reviewed and approved by the Editorial Commission, and if they have not been published or submitted to publication in other journal, with the exception of those presented in congresses as abstracts.

Papers divided in parts 1, 2, ... should be sent together, since they will be submitted to the same reviewers. We ask the authors to consider the following instructions for manuscript organization.

*Bioethics and Biossecurity Committee Approval are required when human or animals are involved. When genetically modified organisms are involved the approval is also needed. Should be stated before the reference section.*

#### Presentation sequence and article structure

The article should be organized as follows:

- a. Title of the article should be restricted to 15 words. Only the first letter of the first word should be a capital letter, except where naming conventions demand otherwise.
- b. Articles should have a **maximum of eight authors**.
- c. The abstract has a maximum of 15 lines.
- d. There should be a minimum of three and a maximum of five keywords, not present in the title
- e. There should be a Portuguese title as per a above
- f. There should be a Portuguese language abstract (Resumo), as an exact translation of the abstract.
- g. Portuguese language keywords (Palavras-chave) should be provided as translation for the keywords, as per e above
- h. The Introduction should emphasize the relevance of the article and include the literature review.
- i. Material and methods should contain all needed information to allow repetition of the research by other teams
- j. Results and Discussion should be discussed and interpreted in the light of the existing literature
- k. Conclusions should be numbered and brief, without comments and additional explanations, based on the results presented
- l. Acknowledgements are optional
- m. References

**Observation:** Title abstract and keywords should be on the language used for the text, followed by the Portuguese or Spanish version, which is in turn followed by the body of the paper.

## **Text edition**

**a. Language:** English, Portuguese or Spanish

**b. Text Processor:** Word for Windows

**c. Font:** Times New Roman, size 12. No words in the text should be bold.

**d. Spacing in the Text:** Double-spacing between the title, resume and abstract; single spacing between items and sub-items; and within the text 1,5 spacing. Paragraph indent: 0,5 cm.

**e. Pages:** Paper A4, portrait, 2,5 cm upper and lower margins, and 3.0 cm left and right margins.

**f.** All the items should be in capital letters, in bold type and centred, except "Resumo", Abstract and Key Words, which should be aligned to the left and only the first letter should be capital. The sub-items should be aligned to the left, in bold type and only the first letter is to be capital.

**g. Units and Dimensions:** Should be expressed in SI (International System) units and the Scientific terminology should follow the international conventions of each area.

**h. Number of pages:** Maximum 20 pages including illustrations and pages not numbered.

**i. Tables and figures** (graphs, maps, images, photographs, designs, etc.)

Tables and figures should have caption in Times New Roman, size 9.

Tables and figures should have 9 or 18 cm of width, with text in Times New Roman, size 9. They should be inserted immediately below the paragraph in which they are mentioned for the first time.

Tables and figures with almost the same caption should be grouped, using capital letters followed by a point on the left upper outer side of the figure to distinguish the components. Grouped figures should be mentioned in the text as Figure 1A. and so on.

There should be no vertical and a minimum of horizontal lines in the tables. The caption for tables should be above the table, and not end in a dot. Tables for mean comparisons, as a result of statistical analysis, should have a space between the value and the letter. Units should be in brackets.

Figures should not have borders and their lines (for graphs) should have a 0.5 pt thickness, with legend identified markers used to distinguish the lines. Axis units should be in brackets, but not separated from the axis title by comma. Figure caption should be below the figure, and not end in a dot.

Figures and tables should not present the same data to avoid redundancy.

Photographs or other types of figures should be scanned with 300 dpi and inserted in the text.

Authors have to use high quality figures to allow good graphic reproduction.

## **Citation in the text**

**a.** Where the citation contains only one author: ... Freire (2007) or ... (Freire, 2007).

**b.** Case of two authors: ... Freire & Nascimento (2007), or ... (Freire & Nascimento, 2007).

**c.** More than two authors: Freire et al. (2007), or (Freire et al., 2007).

## **References**

The article should have, preferably, no more than **25 citations**, in **most recent journals (last 5 years)**.

The references cited in the text should be placed in alphabetical order by the last name of the first author and in the increasing chronological order according as the following examples:

Citations to articles in press, personal communication, folder, monograph, job completion for graduation, technical report and papers at conferences, meetings, seminars, etc., should be avoided in the elaboration of articles.
